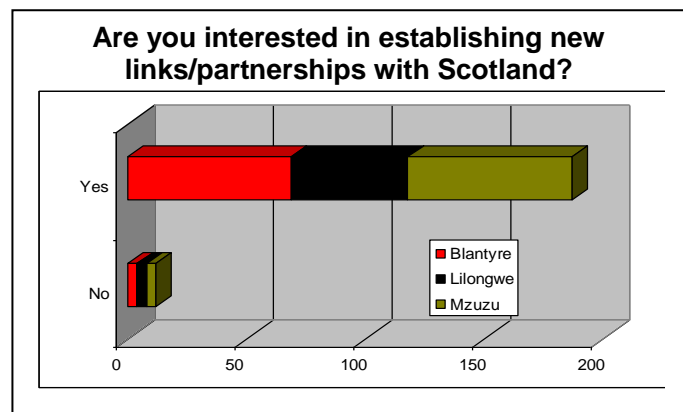


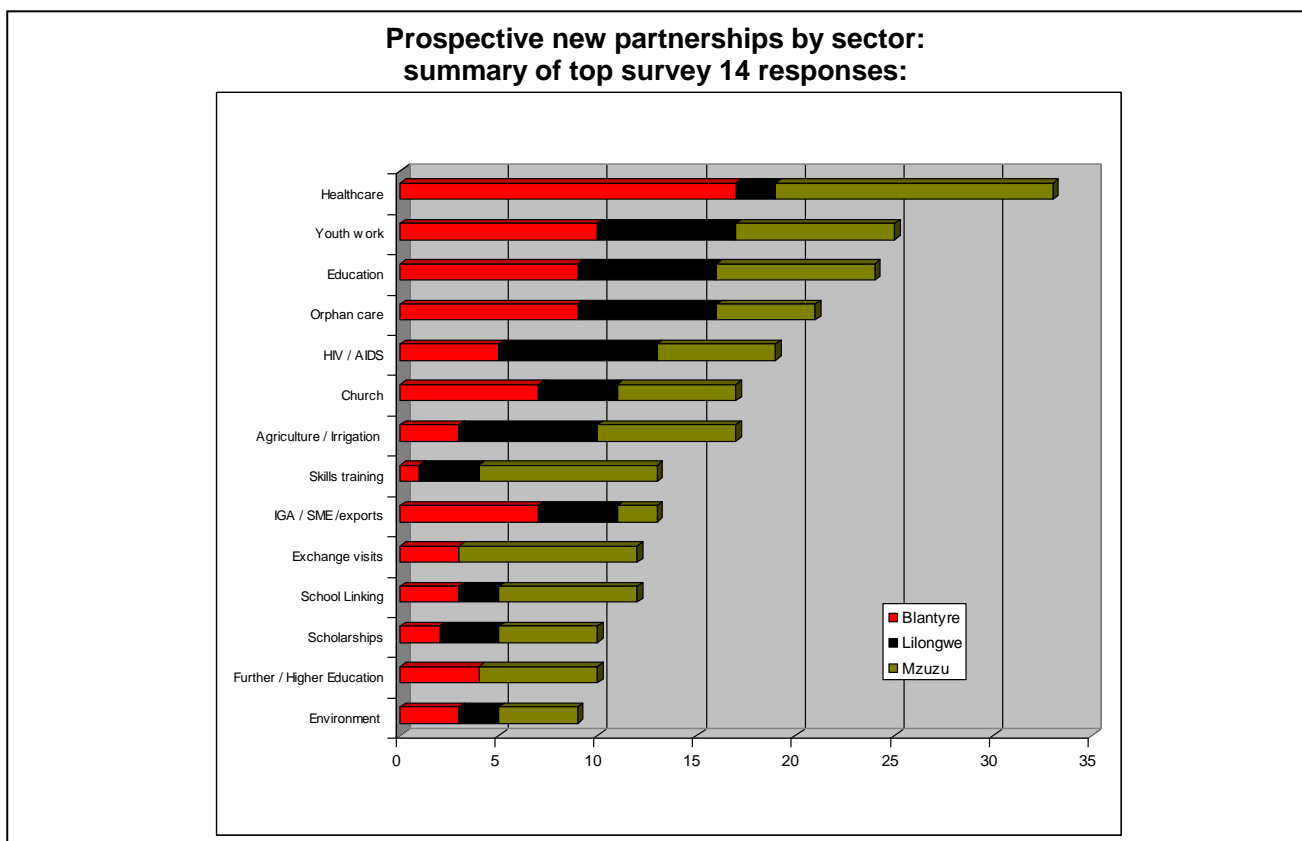
## Malawian Requests for new Scottish Partnerships Information for SMP Members

Between September 2009 and January 2010 the SMP undertook a research exercise throughout Malawi looking, quite generally, at Malawian civil society but also specifically at the Malawian side of all the civil society links with Scotland. Through December 2009 the SMP hosted a series of open stakeholder meetings which were open to anyone who had existing links with Scotland, or who were interested in establishing partnerships with Scotland. At these open stakeholder meetings, delegates were invited to complete a short two-page survey about their existing links and their interest in establishing new partnerships.

The results show that, of the 211 organisations and individuals who completed a survey, 78 (42%) had existing active links with Scotland and 109 (58%) did not. In addition, the survey asked 'Are you interested in establishing new links/partnerships with Scotland?', to which 199 (94%) respondents answered 'yes' and only 12 (6%) answered 'no'.



The 199 who were interested in establishing a new link were then asked 'please summarise the type of organisation/individual you are hoping to engage with, the work you hope to undertake together, and the outcomes you hope to achieve'. The results from this question show that health care, youth work, education, orphan care and HIV/AIDS work were the most frequently requested areas for future work (see below).



This research exercise was not designed to broker new links or to build a case for further funding but rather to explore the issues and priorities in contemporary Malawian civil society, with specific regard to links with Scotland. However, in conducting the research the SMP received over 337 unsolicited requests for prospective new civil society links with Scotland, spanning over 50 sectors/thematic areas. The SMP feels a real responsibility to try and raise awareness of this strong interest from the Malawi-side of the partnership and, where possible, to establish new contacts and help broker new links based on the data collected through the research exercise. Accordingly, the Partnership has collated all the information about prospective new links which was submitted through the surveys and has brought together all the requests, sector by sector, into this document.

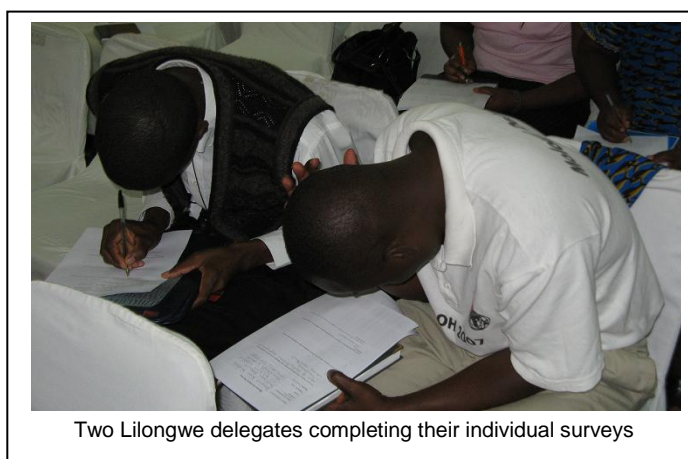
