

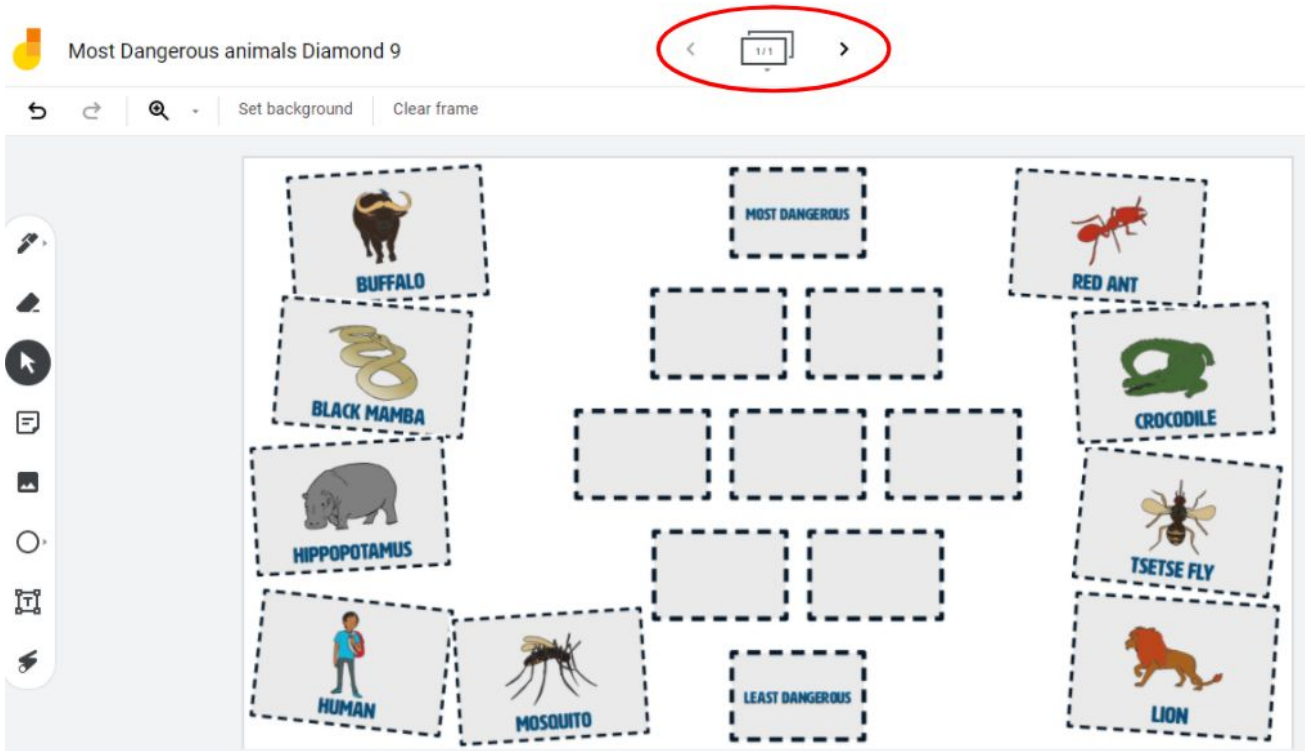

At WOSDEC we've been working with teachers to support them to deliver Global Citizenship Education through home learning. One of the many tools we use is Google Jamboards. In Scotland all teachers have access to the full suite of Google tools through their Glow accounts. Jamboards should be accessible to Malawian teachers if you have a google account, which most humans do now in order to download apps on our phones! We've taken the 'Diamond 9' activity from the Conservation section of the new resource (page 49 of the resource) and turned this into a jamboard.

At the top (circled in red) you can move between numbered frames. This allows you to put your learners into groups and ask each group to look at a different frame. They can add text to explain their choices with their names etc.
