



## MALAWI INITIATIVE PARTNERSHIP AGREEMENT

This certificate formalizes the reciprocal Health Education and Enterprise partnership agreed between

This agreement is prepared to provide form and focus to the arrangements between \_\_\_\_\_ Primary School, Primary School and its supporting partners.

The parties to this agreement have agreed to come together to establish a mutually beneficial partnership. The intent of this partnership is to assist the two named schools in improving pupil's teaching and learning environment with a particular focus around Enterprise and Health Education.

In Addition pilot exploratory initiatives in – Sport as a diversionary Health Activity

The organizations recognize the need to become involved in the development of enterprise in education and therefore commit to the provision of support to the schools in the form of professional and technical personnel resource. The organizations and the schools have identified the following outputs which will form the main elements in the initial stages of the partnership:

- Provide positive health opportunities e.g. sport, healthy eating and diversionary activities to tackle social and cultural issues which cause high instances of AIDS/HIV, Alcohol abuse, drug abuse and smoking, e.g. Music, Sport, In particular relating to underachieving girls, orphans and those from a deprived background)
- Showing of good practice, comparison of teaching and learning, utilization of research in curriculum areas of Enterprise and Health Education
- Showing of good practice, comparison of teaching and Learning in Health related topics .
- Agree joint enterprise initiatives
- Initiate individual pupil to pupil contact (pen pals), to allow sharing of individual personal experiences which will enrich the partnership
- Identify common curricular areas with a view to ensuring they are embedded in each of the partner school's curriculum creating:

- Fund raising to allow pupils from both countries to visit their partner school
