

One of these is the **Rhino** Beetle. **Elephant Shrew, Buffalo Weaver, Leopard Tortoise, Ant Lion**




1. Match the flag to the neighbouring country





2. Which is longest? ("length" is defined by the drawn arrows; maps are not to scale!)






3. Higher/lower? Relative to sea level, is the deepest part of Lake Malawi higher or lower than the deepest part of the deepest freshwater loch in Scotland?

The surface of Lake Malawi is located at 474m above sea level, with a maximum depth of 706m. 474 – 706 = -232m relative to sea level

Loch Morar is the deepest freshwater body in the British Isles with a **maximum depth of 310m**. The loch has a surface elevation of **9m** above sea level. 9 - 310 = -**301m** relative to sea level



4. Which islands are Scottish and which islands are Malawian?(1 point for Scottish or Malawian, 1 point for name)








C Arran: Scotland


