**RE: INVITATION TO A HEALTH STRAND MEETING**

The Malawi Scotland Partnership (MaSP) is a network organization funded by the Scottish government to coordinate the civic links which Malawi has with Scotland. In pursuant of this role, MaSP operates in 4 key thematic areas namely: health, education, sustainable economic development and energy. Under these thematic areas, MaSP works with the government of Malawi officials in the line ministries and they are called '**Strand Leads**'. Strand meetings are held twice a year and are attended by civil society organizations running projects funded by the Scottish government and government representatives among other stakeholders. The strand meetings are chaired by the Strand Lead. In this regard, the strand meeting for the Health sector has been scheduled for the **13<sup>th</sup> of November 2017** from **9am to 11am** at the Ministry of health conference room at Capital hill.

This letter therefore is an invitation to your good office to attend this meeting as an important stakeholder in the health sector in Malawi. The MaSP shall provide refreshments for this meeting.

As you may be aware the Scottish Government will be opening its call for grants for the **2018 to 2023 funding period** soon. - Challenges and opportunities in the health sector and proposals on forward
- Ideas for collaboration and joint-working - both potential consortia or partnerships for this application, and what opportunities for strategic external partnerships
