

Case Study – The Orskov Foundation

The Orskov Foundation, together with the African Moringa and Permaculture Project (AMPP), received funding from the Scottish Government's Small Grants Scheme in March 2014 to for a 3-year project called Food Forests.



This project will demonstrate the potential of Food Forests, sustainably managed, ecologically sensitive, bio-diverse and productive agricultural systems that enhance and replicate the structure and diversity of natural forests, to provide greater food security, nutritional diversity, a source of income and a means to increase resilience to climate change amongst rural households from Kasankha Bay, near to Cape Maclear in Mangochi District.
